Originally from West Virginia, Tony and Sandi lived in North Carolina until they felt God calling them back to West Virginia to minister to the needs of the residents of McDowell County. In addition, to running the food pantry, they provide mission opportunities for any group who feels God leading them to serve the residents of West Virginia.

We would like to help support God's Grace Ministries with other necessary items, such as non-perishable food, cleaning supplies, baby and adult diapers, as well as hygiene items. 
