The Cornerstone Christian Church Leadership Team would like to invite the congregation to a renewed focus on the Stone-by-Stone campaign through July 1, 2022. For those unaware, Stone-by-Stone was the name given to previous endeavors to repay the loan balance of the church facilities.

Cornerstone is blessed to have many new faces since the last direct focus toward Stone-by-Stone over a decade ago. In order to allow new participation, we would like to refocus efforts here once again for the next three months.

The deacons are in the beginning stages of refinancing the current loan balance. If you would like to help the church by making a contribution to the loan, please make your checks payable to Cornerstone Christian Church and designate it for "loan payment" on the memo line. This will greatly help facilitate reducing the current balance and potentially make it easier to refinance the loan.

This is completely voluntary with no obligation to anyone – it is simply an attempt to make everyone aware of a collective effort to reduce the church debt.

The very next morning after I was asked to help contribute to this writing as one of the deacons, my devotional from New Morning Mercies referenced 1 Corinthians 9:10b: *"...because whoever plows and threshes should be able to do so in the hope of sharing in the harvest."*

Here is a profound, economic idea - If we work, we will make money.

And with that money, we have the opportunity to sow back into the places that benefit us spiritually. While Paul suggested they had a right to reap a material harvest from them (but chose not to), what a gift we have to sow back into our community here with our share of the harvest.

The Raiford family currently lives in the village, San Juan Juquita Mixes, outside Oaxaca, Mexico, where they minister to the Mixe people.



The goal of the work in Juquita is self-sustaining, reproducible indigenous churches. Phil’s work involves building relationships and working alongside the people in construction and farming. Meanwhile, Eunice, as a doctor, provides medical care to several villages. Cornerstone supports the Raifords through prayer and monthly support.
