This is the latest update of our efforts to proclaim the Gospel as a body, stand in faith in the face of fear of Covid-19 as light to our world, to end the spirit of isolation while still ensuring the least possible opportunity to spread the disease.

We plan to meet for worship this Sunday at Cornerstone as a Drive-In Church at 10:00 am. While we are still learning and working out the bugs, we have the capacity for folks to listen from the safe zone of their cars in the parking lot. You will have to tune in to FM radio 101.5, the same frequency on which our headsets for hearing impaired broadcast. This only works on our property. For this week, worship leaders will be inside. We hope to move worship leadership outside as weather and circumstances permit for the duration of this unusual time. Offering boxes will be available for folks to come forward to drop offerings in a centrally located spot.

There will be no Sunday School or Children's Church, so parents will need to plan accordingly. Very limited seating will be available indoors for a few, the rest rooms will be open. We will post the recording of Sunday's worship on our Cornerstone Facebook account later Sunday evening.

Please adhere to the following health risk assessment questions. Answering "yes" to any of them means you should stay home and listen to the Facebook broadcast of worship later.

If your answer to any of these questions is "yes", please stay home.

- a. Have you been travelling out of the area?
- b. Have you been exposed to sick people?
- c. Are you sick?
- d. Are you at a critically vulnerable age and of poor general health condition?
- e. Are you pregnant?
- f. Do you care for someone of a vulnerable age and condition of health?

Please know that the Leadership Team is diligent in prayer and obedience to God's call upon His church today, while seeking the latest counsel from our medical brothers and sisters. While doing everything we can to be wise and to follow health and government guidelines, **we first and foremost want to ensure that when the world looks to the church/us for help, they see Jesus.**
