Prayer Calendar - Week One (Prepare our Hearts)

Day 1 - **Recognize and Declare God's Sovereignty** Micah 7:18, Exodus 15:18 & John 17:17

.....Father, I acknowledge that you are the one true God - the One Who has mercy and freely forgives our sin and guilt. There is no one else like you and I worship you for who you are. I will honor You by recognizing that Your Word is the source of Truth.

Day 2 - **Recognize and Declare God's Lordship** John 10:17 & Exodus 3:14-15

.....Lord, I joyfully submit my heart and my life to your sovereignty, recognizing your attributes - Who You are - and releasing my human inclination to mold you into the god I want you to be.

Day 3 - **Humbly acknowledge my humanness and repent** Romans 3:23

.....Heavenly Father, I confess that I have not lived a perfect life, falling short of Your glorious standards. I confess my known sins of \_\_\_\_\_ and commit that I resolve to walk away from these sins and turn back to you.

Day 4 - **Humbly acknowledge my need for a Savior** Romans 3:24-26

.....Almighty God, because I have sinned and the right and just reward for sin is death, I need a perfect Savior to pay that penalty and put me into a right relationship with you. I confess that Jesus Christ is my Savior and I accept His free gift of salvation.

Day 5 - **Create in me a pure heart** Psalm 26:2 & Isaiah 64:8

.....O God, create in me a pure heart and make my spirit right with You. Examine me and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. Mold me into the man/woman/child you created me to be.

Day 6 - **Release your burdens** Genesis 22:14 & Matthew 11:28-30

.....Jehovah Jireh, you are the Lord Who Provides. My heart is filled with worries and anxieties over so many things, yet You are more than able to handle any trouble that comes my way. With you my yoke is easy and my burden is light. I release these burdens to you today: \_\_\_\_\_
